

POSTGRADUATE PROGRAM: “Energy Technologies and Management”

ANNOUNCEMENT FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2017-18

The Mechanical Engineering Department of the Polytechnic School of the University of Western Macedonia, invites interested parties to apply for the postgraduate program of studies “*Energy Technologies and Management*” for the academic year 2017-2018.

The Program aims at fostering and promoting education, scientific research and such knowledge as is relevant to the management and exploitation of energy resources, including fossil fuels and renewable energy sources. Special emphasis is placed on natural gas, which is expected to constitute a major resource throughout the post-lignite period in Greece.

Upon completion of the postgraduate studies, a **Master’s Degree** on “*Energy Technologies and Management*” is awarded to the graduates. The program curriculum requires the attendance of ten (10) taught courses for two academic semesters and the completion of a Master’s dissertation within a third academic semester.

After a careful selection process the University of Western Macedonia accepts graduates of Greek engineering schools, schools of applied sciences, environmental departments and material technologies departments, as well as graduates of equivalent institutions from abroad, or Greek Technological Educational Institutes in related subject areas according to the current Law.

The selection process of the postgraduate students will be performed in accordance with Article 12 of Law 2083/92, as well as Article 4 of Law 3685/2008. The selection criteria include the diploma grade, the performance in undergraduate courses relevant to the specific scientific field and the Diploma Thesis, professional experience, knowledge of a foreign language (notably English), research activity (if any), recommendation letters, as well as additional information provided through the candidate’s curriculum vitae.

The number of selected students for each academic year will not be higher than forty (40).

The Program tuition fees amount to a total of 3.800 €. A potential reduction of the respective amount may eventually be feasible for all students through the provision of scholarships. The degree of decrease depends on the acquirement of private benefaction for the specific Program; a relevant announcement will soon be published on the Program website.

Application for the Program must include the following documents:

1. Printed application (available at the Program website)
2. Copy of Diploma (or first cycle Degree). For students expecting to graduate by September 2017, an official statement of law stating their graduation by the referred time period should be included, together with a declaration of the expected diploma grade.
3. Certified Recognition of Degree issued by DOATAP (National Academic Recognition Information Center), for Degrees acquired abroad.
4. Official transcript
5. Official certificate for the knowledge of one foreign language
6. Curriculum vitae, including information about professional and research activity
7. Two letters of recommendation
8. Photocopy of ID (or Passport)
9. Two passport size photos (in color)
